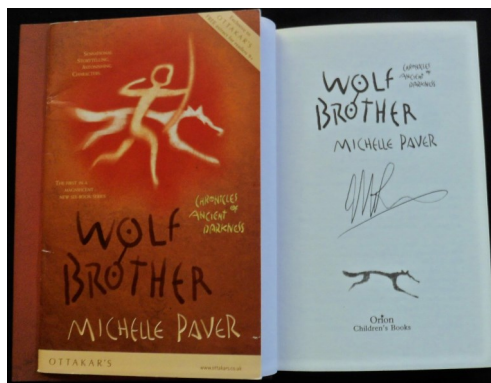

3. STOKER, Bram. Lair of the white worm. W. Foulsham & Co, dated 1911 but later, *foxing to page edges and prelims, spine sunned*

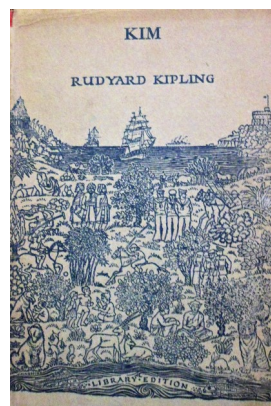
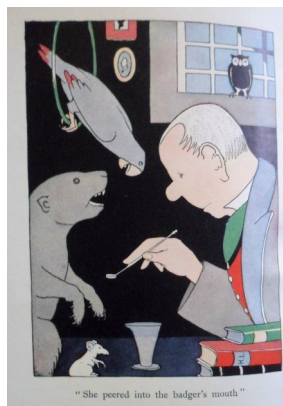
